



## GRACE EPISCOPAL CHURCH

KESWICK, VIRGINIA

In 1845, the sanctuary of this church was built to be a long-lasting example of a House of God. More humble, the 1920s Parish house rests in a delicate balance with the sanctuary and the rural landscape. BRW designed a new Parish Hall to blend seamlessly with the original house, in detail and construction, while simultaneously being unseen from the sanctuary. The original Parish house space is transformed into a generous lobby, adjoining the new timber-framed Parish Hall with a limestone fireplace.
